Day of trial entries accepted if run limits have not been reached.

Crating:

We have a reasonable amount of benching space on a concrete apron within the arena and provide adjacent parking for those wishing to use their vehicles.

Containerized Trial

Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container. See Exhibitor's Handbook for further guidelines.

Entry Limits:

500 Runs Per Day.

(No more than 350 Runs per Day with Jumps)

Move ups:

There will be no same day move-ups. Next Day move-ups will be accepted before the Trial Secretary leaves the building for the night.

Day of show Entries:

Day of show entries will be accepted if the trial has not filled. **(Additional runs may be added at the rate of the original entry)**

Refunds:

Refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date shall be at the discretion of the Trial Committee. An administration fee of \$30.00 per dog "may" be charged except in those cases where accommodations were unavailable. There will be no refunds in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason.

Awards and Ribbons:

Placement ribbons (Skilled & Proficient combined) will be awarded to third place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a Pass/Fail class. A Purple qualifying ribbon shall be given to each qualifying rd in each class. 1st place dogs will also receive a small prize. Titling Ribbons will be available. Any team fortunate enough to complete a NATCH of any kind during the weekend will receive a special award.

Weekend awards will be presented to the top dog at each level (categories, jump heights & divisions combined): Intro, Novice, Open & Elite. All classes will be used with the exception the last class on Sunday (likely Hoopers)

Dogs in the Skilled Category

Dogs with a permanent height card

Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afrm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No clickers, audible aids/toys or open food shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring during a qualifying run. Handlers may attach a small non-audible toy, no larger than their hand, to their leash. The toy cannot be detached. In a Containerized Trial, handlers may use a small container (a zip lock bag works well) to secure food or a small non-audible toy in their pocket during their run. They cannot indicate its presence to the dog until they leave the ring. Only Intro & Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on

behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases **NADAC** (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **PAWSitive Dog Sports Association** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing

committee), and **Cold Lake Agricultural Society** (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will

defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the

foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned

parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

FEES

Package fees are per household. They can be shared with as many dogs & handlers as you have within your household. Prices are listed on the entry form.

Junior handlers pay \$5 per run for the first 10 (maximum of \$50.00). Additional runs are free. Junior handlers are not subject to Day of Show fees.

IMPORTANT Site Information!!

This year we will be again sharing the grounds (through different access points) with snow machine racing on Saturday, possibly Sunday. We will share a concession, but snow machines will not be allowed up to our building. There are no horses boarded on site again this winter, so dogs will be allowed towards the barn (on your left as you enter the grounds) and beyond.
