## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- Dogs must be registered with a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.
- This is a FUN-raiser trial. All proceeds go to Toys for Tots.
- Skilled and Proficient Categories will be combined for placements.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- In the event of a weather cancellation of classes, there will be no refunds. You will receive a credit for any other FUN-raiser trial. If you choose to go home early, then you do not receive a credit for those classes missed.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

**THE MANAGEMENT** will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

### **Non-Jumping classes – Veteran Handler:**

Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive additional standard course time. This division is for handlers only. The additional SCT is for qualifying purposes only for those who may need the additional time to negotiate the course due to physical limitations. Veteran Handlers in the non-jumping classes will be scored and placed with their standard division jump height. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all dogs in this division for the weekend.

**As of January-2014:** Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes .

### **This is a Containerized Trial**

**FOOD/TOYS IN POCKET:** Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys, diminish dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates (or wherever they left their food), and to lessen the amount of insects that are around loose food.

**IMPORTANT.** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) and submitting your request. Your dogs points can be found in the Members Section. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

**Levels.** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

### **Daily Fees and Package Rates:**

Per OWNER Fees: Take the total number of runs the owner is entering at this trial and calculate your entry fee using the following:

1-21 runs = \$10.00 per run 22-43 runs = \$9.00 per run 44+ runs = \$8.00 per run

Junior Handlers = \$10.00 per dog/per day

**DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES:** We will accept day of show entries provided the trial has not filled. The day of show entry fee is \$15.00 a run with no package deals. Please bring a completed/signed entry form with you to the trial.

**Please Note:** In order to receive the PACKAGE PRICE, you must submit payment on line or by mail prior to the closing date of the trial. You cannot enter the trial on line and then pay at the trial and receive the package price. When paying at the trial, the fee is \$15.00 per run.

**AGREEMENT**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members) and River Wind Farm, and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

**Directions:**

**From I-85 South of Oxford:**

Take I-85 North to US-15 N Exit 186A. Continue on US-15N for 5.7 miles. Turn Right on W. Wilton Ave/NC-56. Continue on NC-56 for 3.5 miles. Turn Left on Tar River Road and continue for 3.7 miles. Turn Right on Tom Hunt Road and River Wind Farm will be 0.9 miles down on the left.

**From I-85 North of Oxford:**

Take I-85 South to US-15 Exit 202. Turn Left on US-15 South. Continue for 4.1 miles and then turn Left on Tar River Road. Continue for 2.5 miles. Turn Left on Tom Hunt Road and River Wind Farm will be 0.9 miles down on the left.

**From US-1 South of Oxford:**

Take US-1 North to the NC-56 Exit. Turn Left on NC-56 and continue for 6.9 miles. Turn Right on NC-96 and continue for 2.4 miles. Turn Left on Tom Hunt Road and River Wind Farm will be 1.8 miles down on the right.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Trial is being held on an active working horse farm. Please keep dogs on leash at all times when they are not competing or in warm-up area. Please clean up after your dogs (and yourself). We will leave the arena and farm cleaner than we found it. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on grounds and at hotels. Exhibitors found to be in violation of either of these policies may be excused by Trial Committee without benefit of refund.
